Mike shared the video "Raising More Money" with Terry Axelrod. The video suggested a four-step process for non-profit groups to raise money. The following is a brief summary of Axelrod's remarks:

<u>Step 1</u> Host a Point of Entry Include an Emotional Hook Capture Names from event

Step 2
Follow Up
Thank people for attending
Ask attendees what they thought
Be quiet and Listen
Ask "Is there any way you can see yourself getting involved with us?"
Ask if they can suggest others to invite

Be sure to make multiple contacts between the P.O.E. and the "Ask"

Step 3 Hold a free One-hour Ask Event Event would be **free for all** Can be held during **breakfast** or **lunch** Event must be one hour ONLY! Must start and end on time No minimum or maximum needed to give If event benefits kids, have kids be greeters Begin with a short **emotional hook** Invite people to enjoy their meal for about 10 minutes while looking @ program Have a **visionary leader** talk for about seven minutes. Explain: •Where we've been •Where we are •Where we want to go Include seven-minute video •Video must move people to tears no less than three times Have a live testimonial Have someone make the pitch •He/She should be credible •Help audience to understand the pledge card •Give choices for pledges and multiple year giving •Do not have pledge card on table initially - pass them out during pitch Call everyone who made pledges the next day! Step 4 Introduce Others Have a Point of Re-entry Host a Feel Good Event
