Betty Lowther Music Scholarship

This scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, is offered in memory of Betty Lowther, who devoted much of her adult life to teaching young children to play the piano.

The applicant for this scholarship does not have to be planning to major in music in college or become a professional musician. The recipient will be chosen on the basis of the following six criteria:

- 1. Musical accomplishments, especially contributions to the EHS music program (1-20 points).
- 2. Financial need (1-15 points)
- 3. Recommendations (1-10 points)
- 4. Quality and persuasiveness of essay (1-10 points).
- 5. Academic record (1-10 points).
- 6. Involvement in school and community activities and service (1-10 points).
