KITTITAS COUNTY CATTLEWOMEN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND PROCEDURE

Kittitas County CattleWomen annually provides one scholarship valued at \$750.00. Applicant must be a female Kittitas County High School senior enrolling full-time at a trade school, technical school, community college or university for the 2020/2021 academic year. Applicant must plan for a major or minor in an agriculture related field. This scholarship is renewable for future years beyond application; however, applicant must reapply each year.

One (1) Scholarship at \$750.00 will be awarded for the 2020-2021 academic year. Recipient will be notified of the award by mail no later than May 31, 2021. Kittitas County CattleWomen will make payment directly to the scholarship recipient.

Following are guidelines provided to those who wish to apply for the scholarship:

1. Application: Deadline is April 1, 2021

- a. The attached application must be completed in full and postmarked on or before April 1, 2021 to be considered by the Scholarship Committee. Applications postmarked after April 1, 2021 will not be considered.
- b. Applying in person or by mail does not guarantee eligibility. Applicant is responsible for completing the application in full and seeing that all requested materials are postmarked by the application deadline of April 1, 2021.
- c. Applicants must use a current application form. All application forms will have a current date reflecting the academic year for which the application applies. This date can be located at the top of each application form.
- d. If applicant wishes to use additional paper to complete the application, that is acceptable as long as the question being answered is clearly identified and the same scholarship format is utilized.

2. Transcripts:

- a. Official transcripts of the applicant's high school record must accompany the application. If more than one high school was attended, applicant must submit official transcripts from all schools.
- b. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or above to be considered for this scholarship.

3. References:

- a. Please attach contact information of three references, which may be used by the Scholarship Committee.

4. Signature and Authorization:

- a. Your signature is an essential part of this application. Applications without signatures are ineligible.
- b. Kittitas County CattleWomen request a 3x5 picture/photo (or larger) be enclosed with the application.
